

GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS WEEK #3

Jesus and the Storm, He reveals his power over, LEADER NOTE and in, the storm extending the opportunity for His disciples to have **trust** and **peace**.

KEY TEXT John 6:14-21

BIG IDEA Invite Jesus into your boat (life/situation) when you are in a storm.

John 6:35 - "Then Jesus declared, "I am the bread of life. Whoever KEY VERSE comes to me will never go hungry, and whoever believes in me will never be thirsty."

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- What have we learned so far in this 40-day journey of following Jesus? Leader: You will want to review the big take-aways from weeks 1 and 2 to get the discussion going.
- Without reading from the bible, re-tell what's taking place in chapter 6. Leader: There could be different views or focuses about what is going on here. Make sure you review John 6 personally and text out the participant guide to participants 2-3 days before meeting so that they are prepared.
- What did God teach you through the message this week?
- How can we keep our prayers from turning into idolatry, where we use "God" to get what we want? (v 14-15)



- Since it is not always God's will to deliver us from trials, is it wrong to pray for deliverance? What else should we pray for?

 Leader: No, it's not wrong, but our prayer may need be presented, "Lord give me the grace to walk through this storm with you" or "Lord, guide me through
- Why doesn't the Lord protect those who are seeking to serve Him from difficult trials?
- How can we grow to experience God's presence with us in all situations?

 How would this affect our behavior and emotions?
